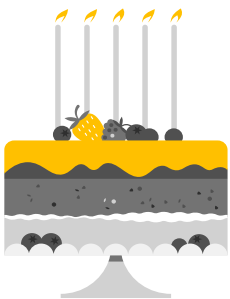
Lastly, we are throwing our Meadowcare Summer BBQ on Tuesday, *1st of August at 3pm* until 5pm. We would be delighted to see you.

Joyce H., Bejay, Wendy, Diane and Margaret R.!



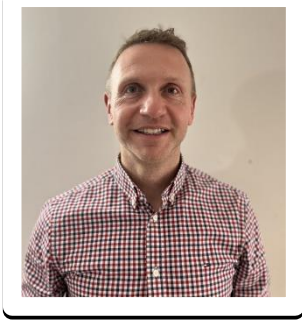
