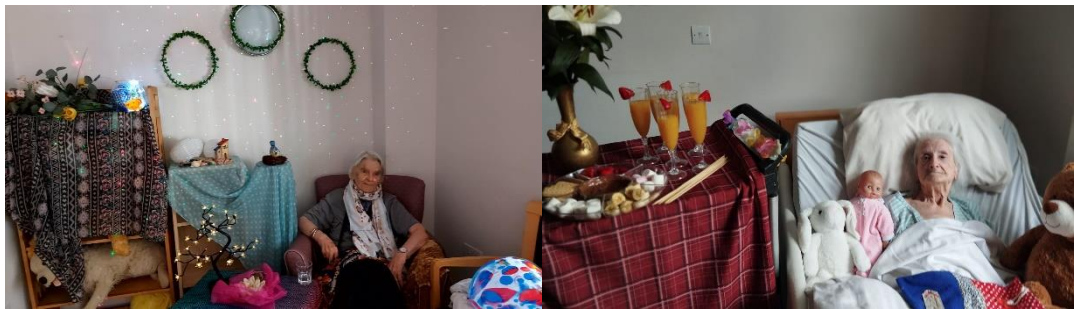
Okay the fun things!
